Public Meeting Notification

Second Street Green Infrastructure Demonstration Project

Green Infrastructure is an approach to managing stormwater by infiltrating it into the ground to recharge the groundwater rather than conveying it to the sewer system. The City of Alexandria is planning to construct a Green Infrastructure Demonstration Project along Second Street between North Pitt and North Royal Streets. The project will reduce the existing paved area and will create green space for trees and a series of bioretention facilities. A major environmental benefit of infiltrating stormwater is a reduction in the frequency of sewer system overflows being released into the Potomac River.

The City will be holding a public meeting to present the project within the framework of other ongoing City initiatives such as the Combined Sewer Long Term Control Plan and the Old Town North Small Area Plan. Time will be set aside at the end of the meeting to answer questions and receive feedback.
